Band Description:

Nova Era is a 3 - 6 piece ensemble that performs revamped classical music with modern rhythms and sounds. Nova Era performs in handcrafted 18th century costumes, and ornate, powdered wigs.

Dressing Room & Catering

One dressing / break room near performance area with:

Lighting in dressing room

10 chairs

- 2 6' banquet tables
- 1 full length mirror
- 1 clothes/coat rack for costumes
- 1 separate 20 amp circuit

Water/soda/coffee service for 10 people set one hour prior to Showtime

<u>Travel Outside of Florida</u>: Nova Era can travel with all backline equipment such as Drums, Keyboards and Bass amplifier for the cost of excess baggage to and from Orlando, Fl. Pricing for excess baggage is determined by Airline Carrier.

Airfare

Eight (8) RT Airfare from Orlando * All flight times and schedules must be approved by ARTIST prior to ticketing *

Ground Transportation

Transportation to/from venue city airport. If hotel rooms are not provided on or adjacent to performance site, ground transportation must be provided to/from hotel and venue.

Accommodations

Five (5) pre-paid double hotel rooms (3 Star or better)


Per Diem

Rate to be determined by Purchaser as appropriate to location. Minimum per diem is \$75 per person, per day on site in US, \$100. International. (*Please note that if the act is required to arrive a day prior to the event, per diem is required on that day*). Per diem is not required on the day the act returns home.

Video Taping

Artist agrees to allow Image Magnification of their performance. Purchaser shall provide Artist with one copy of all footage of Nova Era in Betacam SP format within 10 days following performance at no cost to Artist.

<u>Outdoor Provisions:</u> Purchaser must provide even leveled performance area away from direct sun. A "weather" call should be made minimum 4 hours prior to the performance time. Inclement weather rendering performance impossible, infeasible or unsafe shall not be deemed a force majeure event and payment of the agreed upon compensation shall be made not withstanding.



System should be capable of at least 100db @ 50 Ft. System should provide adequate and even coverage throughout venue. Ideally, system should be "Show Ready" for sound check 4 hours prior to performance. If necessary, Nova Era can mix from the stage right side of the stage.

Ideal Mix position is FOH center 30'-50' From Stage

Front of House should be ideally a tri-amped, 2-3 way w/ subs in stereo. To include all appropriate processors, EQ, cabling and amp racks or a powered system with similar specs. Full range speakers are sufficient for smaller venues.

Minimum Audio Equipment Requests

- 16 x 4 Mix Console with 4 Aux sends
- 16 x 4 (50-100 Ft Audio Snake)
- 4 Band EQ with 2 mid band sweeps/Monitor EQ.
- 1 Stereo FX processor
- *Monitor mixes are Pre-Fader

Lighting:

Appropriate lighting to present Nova Era in a theatrical show. We suggest a minimum 3-color wash.

NOTE: Nova Era can travel with all backline equipment for the cost of excess baggage to and from Orlando, Fl.

Pricing for excess baggage is determined by Airline Carrier.

Set Up, Backline and Monitor Requests

Nova Era lineup consists of a 6 piece musical act. 2-20 amp (120V) AC services should be located upstage left and right. Audio snake(s) should be positioned stage center Front of Drums.

Musicians are: Front stage right to left: Electric Violin – Electric Cello - Oboe

(DI)/Cables Provided (**Band will provide Oboe mic**) Cello player will need a drum throne or similar stool positioned center between Violin and Oboe.

Rhythm section upstage right to: left:

Keyboard - Drums - Bass .

Keyboard should be General Midi compatible preferably "Roland" with an Ultimate support angular stand.1 Small Keyboard Amplifier

Bass 1 Small (Preferably "Kickback" 10" bass amp <u>Drummer does not use a monitor</u>. Band will provide Headphones and Line Mixer.

*Mics: If using acoustic Drums: Paired O/H, Snare/HH, Kick
